MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO.7 HELD ON June 05,2018


Offerings comprised of 22,372 packages alongwith 249 packages of leaf supplements. Prices moved up as strong demand ensued. Withdrawals stood at 8% against 6% last week.


<u>LEAF</u>: Strong competition for the brokens resulted in a rise in prices for the best & good brokens by Tk.3.00-5.00 and more. Mediums and plainer types gained more. Selective best lines fetched between Tk.244.00 - Tk.280.00.

Fannings met improved rates with the best and good types inclining by Tk.2.00-Tk.4.00. Mediums and plainer type gained between Tk.3.00 - Tk.5.00 & ocassionally more. Selective types sold between Tk.239.00 - Tk.249.00.

<u>DUST</u>: There were 4,676 packages alongwith 635 packages of dust supplements on offer. These met strong demand. Most types advanced by Tk.2.00 - Tk.6.00 and more for the well made good liquoring varieties. Best CD's moved up substantially. Dust withdrawals stood at 5% against 9% last week.
