**TEA MARKET REPORT – SALE # 11**

The Sale # 11 held on Tuesday **the 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2018**. The offerings comprised of 28,147 Pkgs of Leaf (190 Pkgs of Old Season Teas) and 7,120 Pkgs of Dust (61 Pkgs of Old Season Teas) on offer met with strong demand .

**CTC LEAF**: All Brokens were strongly competed for and were all round dearer and often advancing by Tk.5/- to Tk.10/- per kilo. Their smaller types followed the similar trend while other types were firm to a dearer market.

Good liquoring Fannings were in strong demand and all types sold at fully firm to a dearer rates often advancing by Tk.10/- and more following quality. Mediums followed the similar trend. Plain types also met with good demand and sold well.
