### TEA MARKET REPORT – Sale 10 held on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2018

CTC LEAF: 27,918 packages of Current Season and 479 packages of Old Season Teas on offer met with a very strong demand which strengthened in the second half.

BROKENS: All BOPs were strongly competed for and were dearer by Tk.5/- to Tk.7/- and sometimes more. Smaller Brokens were also similarly dearer. Other varieties were fully firm to dearer following quality. There was hardly any withdrawals.

FANNINGS: Bright Fannings were a very strong feature and often advanced by Tk. 7/- to Tk.10/-following competition whilst Mediums were also dearer by Tk.5/- to Tk.7/-. Other varieties were fully firm to dearer following quality.

CTC DUST: 7,256 packages of Current Season and 70 packages of Old Season Teas on offer met with a

strong demand. Good liquoring varieties met with good competition and advanced by Tk.5/- to Tk.7/ following quality. Others were also firm to slightly dearer market with hardly any withdrawals. Blenders lent strong support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: Market started on a fairly strong note but as the sale progressed in the second half, demand strengthened where all teas were dearer initially by Tk.5/then by upto Tk.8/- to Tk.10/-. Blenders were very active particularly for the brighter varieties and there was a little more interest from the Loose tea buyers.

Dusts were a dearer market.
