<u>CTC</u> <u>LEAF</u>: All Brokens were strongly competed for and were all round dearer and often advancing by Tk.5/- to Tk.10/- per kilo. Their smaller types followed the similar trend while other types were firm to a dearer market.

Good liquoring Fannings were in strong demand and all types sold at fully firm to a dearer rates often advancing by Tk.8/- to Tk.15/- following quality. Mediums followed the similar trend. Plainer types also met with good demand and sold well.
