**Fannings:** Best types were keenly sought after and sold at firm to occasionally slightly dearer rates. Others were firm. Plainer types were firm to easier in line with quality.

**Dust:** Well made RD and Dusts met with a good demand and mostly sold at around last levels. Medium and the plainer types were irregularly a little easier. CD's continued to meet with a weaker market and eased considerably in value with some withdrawals.

**Comment:** Support from the Blenders continued to be strong and prices for most descriptions held firm on last. Plainer types however, were irregularly eased following quality. Dusts were a firm market. CD's declined substantially and suffered some withdrawals.
