TEA MARKET REPORT – SALE # 30

The Sale # 30 held on Monday **the 26th November, 2018**. The offerings comprised of 44,080 Pkgs of Leaf (234 Pkgs of Old Season Teas) and 7,202 Pkgs of Dust on offer met with less demand at much lower rates.

CTC LEAF: All bright liquoring Brokens met with fair demand but prices eased quite considerably and with the progress of the sale and towards end prices dropped by Tk.10/- Tk.15/- per kilo. Their mediums also met with less demand and where sold took a similar drop. Plainer types were mostly neglected.

Good liquoring Fannings met with fair demand but prices were easier by Tk.10/- to Tk.15/- per kilo. Mediums also met with less demand at much easier rates while plainer types saw very little demand.
