<u>CTC</u> <u>LEAF</u>: All bright liquoring Brokens met with fair demand but prices eased quite considerably and with the progress of the sale and towards end prices dropped by Tk.10/- Tk.15/- per kilo. Their mediums also met with less demand and where sold took a similar drop. Plainer types were mostly neglected.

Good liquoring Fannings met with fair demand but prices were easier by Tk.10/- to Tk.15/- per kilo. Mediums also met with less demand at much easier rates while plainer types saw very little demand.
