

## Tea Auctioneers since 1990 <u>TEA MARKET REPORT – SALE # 38</u>

The Sale # 38 held on Tuesday the  $22^{nd}$  January, 2019. The offerings comprised of 40,340 Pkgs of Leaf (190 Pkgs of Old Season Teas) and 6,903 Pkgs of Dust (85 Pkgs of Old Season Teas) met with strong demand and all types sold at much dearer rates.

<u>CTC</u> <u>LEAF</u>: A handful of clean bright liquoring Brokens met with strong demand and sold dearer rates often advancing Tk.10/- and more. Medium and plainer types also met with strong demand and sold at much dearer rates.

A small quantity of clean Fannings met with strong demand and sold at premium rates. Mediums and the plainer categories also met with strong demand and all types were dearer by Tk.10/- and more.
