Demand: Poor demand at further lower rates with very heavy withdrawals.

Buyers: Blenders were selective whilst Loose Tea Traders were subdued.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: A fair weight of well made bright liquoring types were absorbed by the blenders at rates generally around Tk. 20/= lower than last. Others met with only a limited demand at levels Tk 20/30 below last and a considerable weight remained unsold.

Fannings: Clean good liquoring types met with a fair demand at easier rates of around Tk 20/=. Others shed more and there were heavy withdrawals.
