**Demand:** Strong demand for the well made good liquoring types. Others met with only a selective demand. Withdrawals continue to be heavy.

**Buyers:** Blenders were active whilst Loose Tea Traders lent a fair support.

**LEAF-CTC:**

**Brokens:** Well made good liquoring types met with a strong demand and sold at firm to occasionally dearer rates. Rests were an irregular market and suffered large withdrawals. Plain and the poorer types were difficult of sale.

**Fannings:** Likewise, clean good liquoring varieties were a strong market and sold at firm to dearer rates. Others were firm to little easier and a fair weight remained unsold. Plain and the poorer types were neglected.

**Dust:** Popular good liquoring descriptions met with a good demand and sold at firm to dearer rates. Mediums were irregular with some withdrawals. Plain and the poorer types were mostly withdrawn without any bids.

**Comment:** Once again demand was mostly confined to the well made good liquoring descriptions on offer which sold at firm to dearer levels. Others generally witnessed selective demand at firm to easier rates following quality. Plain and the poorer varieties remained unsold owing to lack of demand .
