

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO.15 HELD ON AUGUST 20, 2019

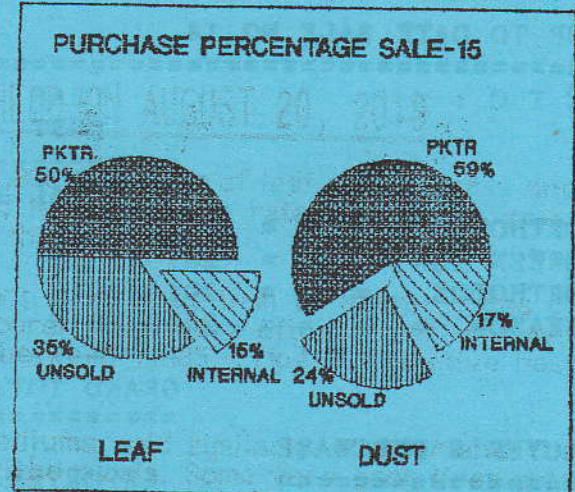
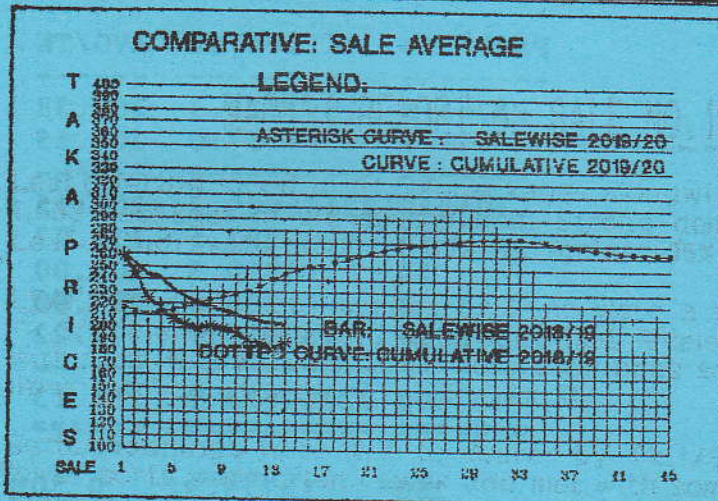
Leaf offering stood at 61,500 packages alongwith 1,899 packages of leaf supplements and 1,553 packages of old season leaf. Strong demand led to dearer rates for most types. Leaf withdrawals stood at 35% as against 35% in the last sale.

LEAF: Good and the medium brokens were a strong market at firm to dearer rates of Tk.2/3. Plainer teas sold at around last levels. Poorer lines were often easier and met with some withdrawals. Some very poor lines sold between Tk.85 - Tk.119. Selective best lines fetched between Tk.225 - Tk.314.

Better fannings were firm to dearer by Tk.1/3. Mediums sold similarly. Plainer and the lower sorts were often easier and met with some withdrawals. Some very poor lines sold between Tk.82 - Tk.119. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.230 - Tk.300.

DUST: 10,182 packages dust alongwith 793 packages of dust supplements were on offer. Good liquoring teas held it levels. Lower types eased by Tk.3/5 or often more and met with fair withdrawals. Dust withdrawals stood at 24% as against 29% in the last sale.

SALE 16: will be held on August 26, 2019 (Monday) at 8.30 A.M. in Sreemongal. Total offerings will comprise of 42,480 packages leaf and 7,895 packages dust.

COMMENTS: Sale 15 was held after a gap of a fortnight because of the Eid Holidays. This was one of the largest weekly sale. Although offering were about 76,000 packages, there was a good demand. Better teas were firm to dearer. There was an improved off-take for the plainer teas. Poorest types faced withdrawals.
