Brokens: Well made good liquoring types met with a strong market and prices ruled dearer by 3/5 and occasionally more. Below best and mediums met with stiff competition and prices advanced by a similar margin. Plainer sorts witnessed an improved demand and gained in value.

Fannings: Best and the below best sorts met with a strong demand and prices advanced by Tk 3/5 over last and occasionally more. Others were also a dearer market. Plainer types sold well at firm to dearer rates.
