LEAF-CTC:

<u>Brokens:</u> Cleaner types were readily absorbed mainly by the Blenders at rates generally Tk 3/5 below last. Select few lines tended firm. Mediums sold well but eased by Tk 5/= from last. Plainer types met with selective demand and suffered fair withdrawals.

<u>Fannings:</u> Best and the below best types met with a fairly strong demand at levels mostly Tk 3/5 below last. Occasional lines were about firm. Mediums eased by around Tk 5/= whilst plainer types met with selective interest and a fair weight remained unsold.
