Buyers: Blenders were fairly active whilst Loose Tea Traders operated selectively.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types met with a good demand and sold at rates Tk. 3/5 below last. Mediums witnessed limited demand at easier levels. Plain and poorer sorts met with irregular demand at easier rates and suffered substantial withdrawals.

Fannings: Best and below best types sold well at drops of Tk 3/5 from last. Mediums met with fair demand at similarly easier rates. Rest met with selective demand and suffered large withdrawals.

Dust: Clean good liquoring descriptions met with a fairly good demand and sold at rates firm to upto Tk. 5/= below last following quality. Others shed more. CD's were generally easier.

Comment: Well made good liquoring varieties were readily absorbed by the Blenders at generally little easier levels than last. Select few lines however, were about steady. There were fairly large withdrawals in the plain and poorer category. Loose Tea Traders were less active than last.
