Demand: Less demand at easier rates with heavy withdrawals.

Buyers: Packeteers lent fair support. Loose Tea Buyers were rather selective.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Better types met with a fairly good demand at rates easier by Tk. 5/7 and occasionally more. Select few popular well made types however, eased less. Mediums met with less demand and prices declined by Tk. 10/= from last. Plain sorts were mostly neglected and where sold, eased by Tk. 10/12 below last.

Fannings: Clean well made types sold well at rates Tk. 5/7 lower than last. Mediums met with less demand and prices eased by around Tk. 10/= . Others met with a very limited demand and suffered heavy withdrawal.

Dust: Cleaner sorts sold well at drops of Tk 3/5. Mediums shed more. Plain and the poorer types were neglected. There were some withdrawals.

Comment: Offering was the heaviest so far recording in the Chattogram Auction. Blenders held lower limits whilst Loose Tea Traders were rather selective. Prices as such, declined further and a heavier weight remained unsold particularly in the re-printed category.
