

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO.25 HELD ON OCTOBER 28, 2019

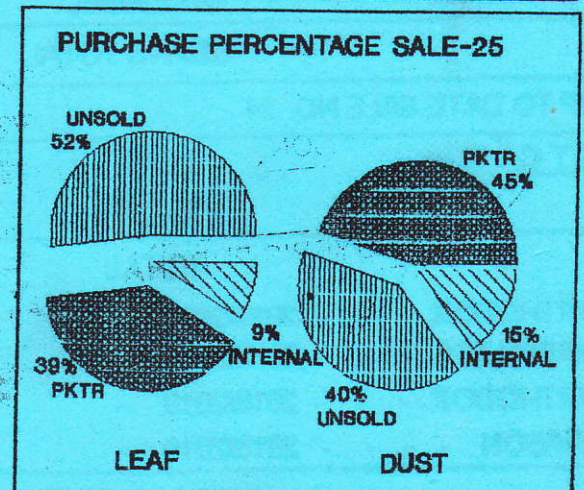
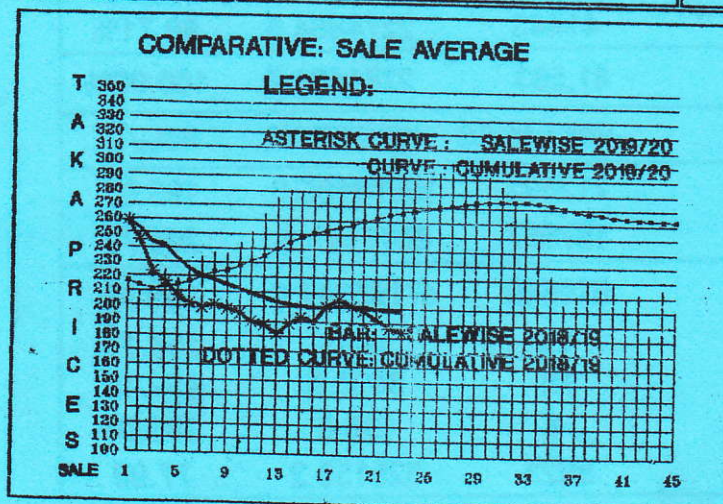
This sale held in Sreemongal comprised of 44,614 packages leaf alongwith 2,950 packages of leaf supplements. Much lower demand led to easier rates and substantial withdrawals which stood at 52% against 52% last week.

LEAF: Best and good brokens met fair demand at slightly easier rates. Mediums shed Tk.5/8. Plainer types declined Tk.8/10. Poorer types and the Northern teas eased further and met withdrawals. Poor lines sold around Tk.80.00 - Tk.95.00. Selective best types ranged between Tk.212.00 - Tk.321.00.

Best and good fannings met good demand but were easier by Tk.3/4. Mediums shed Tk.4/8. Plainer fannings declined by Tk.8/9. Poor and Northern teas, where sold declined Tk.10/12. Some poor types sold at Tk.80.00 - Tk.95.00. Selective best teas sold around Tk.210.00 - Tk.300.00.

DUST: 8,480 packages alongwith 215 packages of supplement was on offer. There was less demand with prices easing by Tk.4/6 and more following quality. Withdrawals were higher and stood at 40% against 33% last week.

SALE 26: will be held on November 28, 2019 (Tuesday) at 8.30 A.M. in Chattogram. Total offerings will comprise of 73,850 packages leaf and 13,153 packages dust.

COMMENTS: There was weaker demand with most types selling at easier rates except the good liquoring ones. Plain, poor types, Northern teas and the large quantity of re-printed teas were difficult of sale and met with substantial withdrawals.
