LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: A limited weight of the well made good liquoring types available met with a fairly strong demand and sold at firm to little dearer rates. Below best and the mediums were firm to occasionally a shade dearer. Plain and the poorer types met with a fair demand and sold at around last levels.

Fannings: Select few best types available were well competed for by all sections of the market and sold at firm to little dearer rates. Others were about firm. Plain and the poorer types met with selective demand at firm to little easier rates.

Dust: Clean good liquoring types met with a better demand and ruled firm to little dearer than last. Others were firm. Cleaner CD's were a strong feature and appreciated in value.

Comment: Well made good liquoring descriptions offered were well competed for and often gained a little in value. Mediums met with a slightly more demand at generally firm rates. There was fair interest of the lower end of the market. Re-print and the plainer types continued to be difficult of sale.
