LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Better sorts met with a fairly good demand but generally eased by Tk. 5/= from last. Others met with only a limited demand at easier rates and suffered heavy withdrawals. There was fair interest at the lower end of the market at levels between Tk. 90/110.

Fannings: Cleaner types met with a good demand and sold at rates Tk 3/5 below last. Others shed more. Plain and the poorer types met with a fair demand at levels between Tk 95/110.

Dust: Met with only a fair demand. Select few clean good liquoring types sold at irregularly firm to generally easier rates whilst others met with only a limited demand and suffered fair withdrawals. Cleaner CD's were absorbed at around last levels.

Comment: There was apparently less demand from all sections of the market resulting in lower rates and large withdrawals this week. A handful of the cleaner types available sold well but shed in value. Withdrawals were heavy and generally confined to the re-prints, mediums and the plainer types on offer.
