Quality: Mostly plain.

Demand: Poor demand at further lower rates.

Buyers: Blenders as well as Loose Tea Buyers lent selective support.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: A small weight of better types on offer met with fair demand at easier rates of Tk. 5/7. Medium and plainer sorts met with selective demand and prices declined by Tk 5/10. Poor type teas met with some interest at irregularly easier rates. Withdrawals were heavily.

Fannings: A limited weight of clean well made types available met with some interest at generally easier rates of Tk 3/5 below last. Others met with a poor demand at drops of Tk 5/10 from last. Poorer types met with only a fair demand with some interest. Withdrawals were significant.

Dust: Well made good liquoring types sold well at around last levels. Medium and plainer sorts eased by Tk 5/7 and suffered some withdrawals.

Comment: Quality of offer were mostly plain and end season types. There was less demand and prices for particularly all descriptions eased further. Withdrawals continued to be heavy and re-printed teas were neglected. Packeteers were selective whilst Loose Tea Traders operated at the bottom end of the market where prices ranged between Tk 75/110 per kg.
