MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO.42 HELD ON FEBRUARY 25, 2020


55,029 packages leaf along with 1,246 packages of leaf supplements were on offer. There was an improved demand at often dearer rates. Leaf withdrawals stood at 48% as against 45% last week.


LEAF: Small quantity of good brokens were firm to dearer. Medium were in better demand. Plainer and the lower types were mostly firm to dearer. Some very poor lines sold between Tk.50.00-Tk.58.00. Selective best lines fetched between Tk.205.00-Tk.258.00.

Limited quantity of good fannings were generally dearer. Mediums inclined. Lower types were strongly competed for at irregularly dearer rates. Some very poor lines sold between Tk.52.00 - Tk.59.00. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.202.00 - Tk.291.00.

DUST: 7,517 packages alongwith 341 packages of supplements were on offer. Prices often eased and withdrawals were large. Dust withdrawals stood at 42% as against 58% last
