Brokens: A negligible weight of the cleaner types available sold well at firm to dearer rates. Plain and the poorer types met with a fairly strong demand and sold at firm to dearer rates following quality. There were however, some withdrawals.

Fannings: A nominal weight of the better types offered sold readily at firm to dearer rates. Plain and the poorer types were a fairly strong market and firm to dearer rates in line with quality.
