**Brokens:** These were mostly a strong feature and sold at dearer rates of Tk 5/10 following quality. Poor, fibrous types however, were little easier and suffered a few withdrawals.

**Fannings:** Met with a good demand at firm to little dearer rates. Poor and the fibrous types were little easier and there were a few withdrawals.

**Comment:** Demand for Brokens this week were noticeably stronger than corresponding Fannings. Loose Tea Traders were the major out-lets whilst Blenders operated selectively. A nominal weight of the cleaner types offered sold well at premium rates.
