Demand: Fairly good demand at easier rates.

Buyers: Major Blenders were active. Loose Tea Traders were selective.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Clean well made types sold well but eased by Tk 10/= from last. Below best types shed a little more. Medium and the plainer types eased by Tk 10/15 and suffered fair withdrawals.

Fannings: Met with a fair demand. Best types sold well but shed Tk. 10/= from last. Others eased more and suffered fair withdrawals.

Old Season: Met with a limited demand and majority remained unsold.
