LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Select few best types sold well at rates Tk 5/8 below last. Others met with only a limited demand at levels Tk 5/10 below last with fair withdrawals.

Fannings: Met with a fair demand. A small weight of the popular good liquoring types sold well but eased by Tk 5/7 below last. Others met with selective demand at rates Tk 5/7 below last and there were fairly large withdrawals.

Old Season: Mostly sold between Tk. 100/120 per kg.
