LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Select few lines of popular well made types sold well at around last levels. Rest were easier by Tk 5/7 and occasionally more with majority remaining unsold.

Fannings: A small weight of the best types offered sold well at around last levels. Others met with only a selective demand and suffered heavy withdrawals.
