LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Met with a strong demand. Clean well made types were dearer by upto Tk. 5/10 and occasionally more. Others were also a strong market and sold at firm to dearer rates. Teas from the Northern District sold well at rates Tk 10/15 above last.

Fannings: Best types were a strong market and sold at rates Tk 5/7 higher than last. Below best and the mediums sold readily at firm to dearer rates. Plain types too inclined in value.

Dust: Met with a good demand. Cleaner varieties sold at generally firm rates whilst others were barely steady. CD's mostly held on to last levels.

Comment: Strong all-round demand led prices to move up quite considerably over last. There was frequent competition amongst Buyers for their share resulting in price escalation. Withdrawals were fewer.
