Brokens: Select few popular well made types were a strong feature and sold at firm to dearer rates. Others were generally firm to little easier following quality. Teas from Northern District suffered considerable withdrawals as bids received were well below Sellers' price idea.

Fannings: Best types sold well at firm rates. Select few lines inclined following competition. Others were firm to little easier. Plainer types were easier and suffered some withdrawals.
