Buyers: Blenders operated in strength. Loose Tea Traders lent good support.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types met with a good demand and generally sold at firm to occasionally slightly dearer rates following quality. Mediums met with a fairly strong demand and ruled firm to little dearer. Plain types met with a fair demand and sold at around last levels.

Fannings: Best and the below best types were a fairly strong feature and sold at rates firm on last. Select few lines tended dearer. Others were also a firm market. Plain types met with selective interest.

Dust: Met with a fairly good demand. Prices however, were easier by Tk. 5/10 for most descriptions and there were some withdrawals.

Comment: Well made good liquoring descriptions were keenly sought after by all sections of the market and prices held firm on last. Blenders were noticeably forceful. Teas from the Northern District witnessed less interest and consequently suffered heavy withdrawals.
