Brokens: Well made good liquoring types were readily absorbed at firm to easier rates of Tk. 5/= than last. Others sold well around previous level. Plainer descriptions met with selective demand at Tk. 5/= easier than last with large withdrawals.

Fannings: Clean well made types met with fairly good demand and sold well at firm to little easier rates of upto Tk. 5/=. Plainer types were easier with fairly large withdrawals.
