LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Better types sold well but generally eased by Tk 3/5. Below best and the Mediums sold similarly. Plainer types were about steady but suffered some withdrawals.

Fannings: Best types sold well at firm to little easier rates. Mediums were steady. Plainer types held on to last rates, where sold.

Comment: Demand emanated mostly from the Blenders who operated actively. Loose Tea Traders however, were much less active. Prices were generally easier and there were some withdrawals especially in the plainer category and those from the Northern District.
