

Tea Market Report

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO.20 HELD ON OCTOBER 12,2020


Leaf offerings consisted of 43,821 packages alongwith 2963 packages of leaf supplemnts. Prices eased further. Leaf withdrawals stood at 47% as against 48% last week.

LEAF: Good brokens eased by Tk.4/5. Mediums declined by Tk.5/8. Lower types shed Tk.8/10. Northern brokens sold between Tk.152.00 - Tk.169.00. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.213.00 - Tk.264.00.

Better fannings declined by Tk.5/6. Mediums depreciated further. Lower types fell by Tk.7/10. Northern fannings fetched between Tk.150.00 - Tk.163.00. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.210.00 - Tk.265.00.

DUST: 9,023 packages alongwith 768 packages of supplements were on offer. There was a better demand than the leaf section. Prices were generally little lower than last. Dust withdrawals stood at 26% as against 31% last week.

COMMENTS: Market eased further by Tk.4/8. Northern teas met with large withdrawals. Fannings were in less demand and eased more than the brokens. Dust were a better Market and withdrawals were less than the leaf grades. Packeteers were the mainstay. Internal buyers operated for negligible quantities.
