LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types met with a good demand and generally sold at around last levels. Others were easier by upto Tk 5/= with fair withdrawals.

Fannings: Clean good liquoring types met with a fair demand but generally eased by Tk. 2/3 from last. Medium and the plainer types shed Tk 3/5 and there were fair withdrawals.

Green Tea: A small weight of Hyson grade from Champarai Tea Estate offered sold at between Tk. 1100/= to Tk. 1150/= per kg.


