LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Better types especially those with useful cup sold well at firm rates. Others were irregularly firm. Lesser types eased a little and suffered fair withdrawals.

Fannings: Best and the below best types were well supported by all sections of the market and generally sold at around last rates. Mediums were about steady to occasionally little easier. Plainer types were easier and suffered fair withdrawals.

Green Tea: A small weight of Hyson grade from Champarai Tea Estate offered sold at Tk. 900/= per kg.
