LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made types, especially those with brighter cup met with a good demand and sold at firm rates. Smaller types were a stronger feature and often gained a little in value. Mediums were steady whilst plainer types were irregularly easier and suffered some withdrawals.

Fannings: Best and the below best types met with a good demand and sold at firm to little dearer rates. Mediums were about firm. Plainer types were firm to little easier and there were a some withdrawals in this category.

Dust: Clean good liquoring descriptions met with a fairly strong demand and were generally a dearer feature. Others were firm to little easier with a few withdrawals. CD's were a strong market, especially the cleaner types.
