Quality: Fairly useful.

Demand: Improved demand at firm to dearer rates following quality.

Buyers: Blenders as well as the Loose Tea Traders were active.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types sold well at firm rates. Smaller types were a fairly strong market and ruled dearer by Tk 2/3. Mediums were steady. Plainer types were firm to little easier with some withdrawals.

Fannings: Best and the below best types were a fairly strong market and sold at firm to dearer rates of Tk 2/3. Others were mostly steady on last. Plainer types were often a little easier and suffered some withdrawals.

Green Tea: A small weight of Hyson grade from Champarai and Madabpore Tea Estate offered sold at between Tk. 550/= to Tk. 900/= per kg.

Dust: Met with a fairly strong demand. Clean good liquoring types were generally dearer by Tk. 3/5 and occasionally a little more whilst others were about firm. Plainer types were irregularly a little easier and there were a few withdrawals.

Comment: A stronger note prevailed throughout the sale particularly for the clean good liquoring varieties on offer. Others met with a little improved demand. There were however, some withdrawals especially in the plainer category.
