LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Clean good liquoring types sold well at about firm rates. Smaller types met with a fairly strong demand and were fully firm to a shade dearer. Others mostly sold at around last rates. Plainer types were irregularly a little easier and suffered a few withdrawals.

Fannings: Best and the below best types were a good market and generally sold at around last rates. Mediums were firm to irregularly little easier whilst plainer types were a little easier with a few withdrawals.

Green Tea: A small weight of Hyson grade from Champarai Tea Estate offered sold at between Tk. 900/= to Tk. 950/= per kg.
