LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Clean well made types sold well at rates firm to Tk. 1/2 easier than last. Medium and the plainer types mostly sold at around last levels.

Fannings: Best and the below best types met with a fairly good demand and generally sold at firm to little easier rates than last. Mediums were a shade easier whilst plainer types were mostly firm.

White Tea: A nominal weight of Silver Needle grade from Madabpore Tea Estate offered sold at Tk. 5000/= per kg.
