# Tea Auctioneers since 1948 TEA MARKET REPORT – Sale 29 held on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2020

CTC LEAF: 46,664 packages of Current Season and 50 packages of Old Season teas on offer met with a fairly strong demand.

BROKENS: Well made good liquoring BOPs were again a good market and were generally firm on last. Their GBOPs met with a stronger demand and were mostly a little dearer over last. Their Mediums continued to sell well and tended dearer. Plain and BLF teas were well supported and were often dearer particularly the BLFs. There were some withdrawals. FANNINGS: Well made good liquoring Fannings were again a strong market and were fully firm with a few select bright lines tending dearer. Mediums were a fairly good market and mostly sold at around last levels. Plain and BLFs were once again a fairly good

market and were well absorbed at around last week's

levels with some withdrawals.

CTC DUST: 9,292 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with a strong demand. Well made good liquoring Dusts sold well at around last levels. Mediums were a better market following competition and these sold at firm to slightly dearer rates. Plain and BLFs met with some interest at easier rates with a few withdrawals. Blenders lent strong support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: Demand continued to emanate from all sections of the market. Blenders provided useful support with Loose tea buyers also being quite active. Dusts sold well.



The best, good and better medium category larger and medium Brokens sold easier by Rs 5/- to 7/- and sometimes more whilst the medium and plainer teas of this category were irregular around last. The plainer smaller Brokens and Fannings were firm to dearer by Rs 2/- to 4/-, whilst the other category smaller Brokens were barely steady. The best liquoring smaller Brokens and Fannings were easier by Rs 6/- to 8/-. The major Blenders continued to remain as the mainstay of the market. The upcountry packeteers were limited in their buying. The other regional buyers continued to operate actively and picked up a fair volume of teas. Internal and the local traders were fairly active. Improved export activity was witnessed on the range of bolder Brokens and Fannings.
