## Tea Auctioneers since 1948 TEA MARKET REPORT - Sale 31 held on Monday 28th December, 2020

CTC LEAF: 38,228 packages of Current Season and 60 packages of Old Season teas on offer met with a fairly good demand.

BROKENS: Well made good liquoring BOPs met with a little less demand and were slightly easier whilst their GBOPs were a good market and were mostly firm. Medium varieties met with quite a strong demand and were irregularly dearer. Plain and BLFs were also a good market and were fully firm to slightly dearer.

FANNINGS: Well made good liquoring Fannings met with a good demand but were a slightly easier market. Mediums once again met with a good demand and tended dearer. Likewise, Plain and BLF teas were also a dearer market.

CTC DUST: 10,465 packages of Current Season teas on offer met with a good demand. Select few lines of

Ds and CDs met with a good competition and advanced by Tk.5/- to Tk.7/-. Other cleaner, well made bright liquoring teas sold at last levels. Their Mediums were firm to slightly dearer closely following quality. However, plain and BLF teas met with a limited demand at easier rates with quite fair withdrawals. Blenders lent strong support with fair interest from the Loose tea buyers.

COMMENTS: Demand was well maintained this week but there were less number of buyers operating in the market. Blenders continued to be active whilst Loose tea buyers were more selective.

Good liquoring Dusts were a strong feature of the sale.


