LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Clean well made types were keenly sought after by all sections of the market and sold at rates Tk 3/5 above last and occasionally a little more. Medium and the plainer types were firm to little dearer following quality.

Fannings: Best types were a fairly strong market and sold at firm to dearer rates of Tk 2/3. Others were a good market and were generally firm to dearer.

Green Tea: A small weight of Hyson grade offered sold at Tk 1650/2450/= per kg.
