LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Select few well made good liquoring types were well sought after by all sections of the market and sold at little dearer rates. Others were firm. Plainer types were firm to little dearer..

Fannings: Best and the below best types sold well at rates generally around last. Mediums were firm whilst plainer types often appreciated by Tk 2/3.

Green Tea: A small weight of Hyson grade offered from Champarai and Brindabon Tea Estate were readily sold at between Tk 1850/2150/= per kg.
