Quality: Similar to last.

Demand: Fairly good demand at firm to generally little easier rates.

Buyers: Blenders were fairly active whilst Loose Tea Traders mostly operated at the lower end of the market.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types met with good demand and sold at firm to easier rates of Tk. 2/3. Bulk of the medium and plainer sorts were absorbed at Tk 3/5 below last.

Fannings: Best types were a fairly strong market and sold at firm to little easier rates than last. Mediums mostly held firm on last. Plainer sorts were firm to little easier following quality.

Green Tea: A small weight of Hyson grade offered from Brindabon and Champarai Tea Estate were readily sold between Tk. 1200/1450 per kg.
