Brokens: A nominal weight of well made good liquoring types offered sold well but little easier rates. Others met with a fair demand at rates Tk. 3/5 below last with some withdrawals.

Fannings: Likewise, a few lines of well made good liquoring types available were readily absorbed at slightly easier rates. Others were easier by Tk. 3/5 and there were some withdrawals.

Dust: Select few clean good liquoring types sold well at about firm rates. Others were easier by Tk. 3/5. CD's were a good market especially the cleaner types.

Comment: There was only a fair demand for the bulk of the plainer types on offer which were generally an easier market. Blenders lent fair support whilst the loose tea traders operated rather selectively. Teas from the Northern District witnessed fair support at little easier rates. Dusts met with a fairly good demand.
