## MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO.7 HELD ON JUNE 21,2021


26,756 packages leaf alongwith 1681 packages of leaf supplements were advertised for sale. Good demand led to a firm to slightly dearer rates. Leaf withdrawals stood at 25% as against 29% last week.

LEAF: Good brokens were firm to dearer by Tk.1/3. Mediums sold at around last rates. Plainer types were a steady market. Northern brokens were about firm on last and sold between Tk.155.00 - Tk.179.00. Selective best lines sold between Tk.223.00 -Tk.233.00 and 3 lines between Tk.259.00 - Tk.270.00.

Best fannings were firm to often dearer by Tk.1/2. Most others sold at around last levels. Northern fannings sold between Tk.160.00 - Tk.181.00. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.221.00 - Tk.238.00 and 2 lines between Tk.260.00 - Tk.275.00.

DUST: 8,724 packages alongwith 1011 packages of supplements were on offer. Strong demand led to firm rates. Dust withdrawals stood at 15% as against 18% last week.

<u>COMMENTS</u>: Good all-round demand led to a fairly strong market at firm to often dearer rates. Most packeteers were quite active as were the local traders. Market has shown signs of improvement with the arrival of good second flush teas.
