LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types on offer were well sought after by the Blenders and sold at rates firm to occasionally dearer following competition. Below best and mediums met with fair demand at easier rates of Tk 2/3 below last. Plainer sorts eased by a similar margin and witnessed fairly large withdrawals.

Fannings: Clean good liquoring types sold well at generally firm rates. Mediums met with a fair demand at Tk 2/3 easier than last. Plainer types witnessed a limited demand at easier rates of Tk 2/3 and suffered substantial withdrawals.




