

MARKET REPORT ON SALE NO.4 HELD ON MAY 31,2021


23,685 packages leaf alongwith 195 packages of leaf supplements were advertised for sale. There was fair demand at generally lower rates than last. Leaf withdrawals stood at 39% as against 39% last week.


LEAF: Good and the medium brokens were lower by Tk.5/6. Plainer lines sold similarly. Selective best lines ranged between Tk.222.00 - Tk.251.00. Northern brokens sold between Tk.165.00 - Tk.182.00.

Cleaner fannings eased by Tk.3/5. Others declined by Tk.5/6. Selective best lines sold between Tk.216.00 - Tk.247.00. Northern fannings sold between Tk.169.00 - Tk.184.00.

<u>DUST</u>: 6,091 packages alongwith 580 packages of supplements were on offer. There was a strong demand at firm to dearer rates. Powdery lines were strong. Dust withdrawals stood 16% as against 12% last week.

SALE NO:- 5 will be held on June 07, 2021 at 8:30 A.M. in Chattogram. Total offerings will comprise of 24,948 packages leaf and 6,451 packages dust.

<u>COMMENTS</u>: There was only a fair demand and prices eased below last levels as buyers held on to lower limits. Dust were however a strong market. Though production levels are below last year, prices are on the decline as consumption has declined due to Covid with buyers reporting a fall in sales.
