LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types sold well but shed Tk 3/5 from last. Below best and the mediums met with a fair demand at easier rates of Tk 2/3. Plainer types met with less demand and where sold, eased by Tk 3/5 from last.

Fannings: Best and the below best types were absorbed mainly by the Blenders at rates Tk 3/5 easier than last. Mediums met with a fair demand at easier rates of Tk 2/3 whilst plainer types were easier by Tk 3/5 with fairly large withdrawals.

Clean good liquoring types sold well but shed more whilst others met with only a fair demand. A substantial weight however, remained unsold owing to lack of demand.
