Brokens: Well made good liquoring types sold well at levels generally firm on last. Below best and the mediums were easier by Tk 2/3. Plainer types met with selective demand at easier rates of Tk 1/2 from last.

Fannings: Best types were a good market and sold at rates firm on last. Below best and the mediums eased by Tk 1/2. Plainer types met with selective interest and eased by Tk 2/3.
