LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types sold well at firm to occasionally slightly dearer rates. Below best and the mediums were firm. Plainer types were firm to irregularly slightly dearer following quality. There were however, some withdrawals.

Fannings: Best types were firm whilst below best and the mediums were firm to Tk 1/2 dearer following quality. Plainer types were firm to little dearer. Poorer types however, were neglected.

Dust: Clean good liquoring descriptions sold well at firm to little dearer rates. Others were little easier and suffered some withdrawals. Cleaner CD's sold well whilst lesser types were neglected.

Comment: Blenders continued to operate actively and accounted for majority of the teas sold. Loose Tea Traders lent fairly good support. Well made good liquoring types attracted keen interest from all sections of the market and often gained in value. There were some withdrawals, mostly in the plainer category.
