Demand: Good demand at generally firm levels.

Buyers: Blenders were active whilst Loose Tea Buyers lent a fair support.

LEAF-CTC:

<u>Brokens:</u> Well made good liquoring types were readily absorbed at firm levels. Below best and mediums met with good demand at generally firm to occasionally slightly dearer rates following quality. Plainer sorts were steady.

<u>Fannings:</u> Best and below best types were a fairly strong market and sold at rates firm on last. Medium and the plainer types mostly sold at around last rates. Poorer types were neglected.

<u>Dust:</u> Met with fairly good demand. Clean, good liquoring types sold well at firm to occasionally dearer rates following competition. Others were mostly firm to occasionally a little easier.

<u>Comment:</u> Offering was the largest so far this season which, however, met with good demand from all sections of the market. Clean good liquoring types were much sought after whilst others met with sustained demand. Cleaner Dusts were a good market.
